You probably never heard about it, but...



About 1,450 black babies are aborted everyday in the U.S.⁽¹⁾

African-Americans make up about ten percent of Pennsylvania's population, yet black women account for **38 percent of abortions** in the state.⁽²⁾



Since 1973, **more than twice** as many blacks have died from abortion than from heart disease, cancer, accidents, violent crimes, and AIDS **combined**.⁽³⁾



Approximately 14 million African-American children have died since *Roe v. Wade* made abortion legal for any reason throughout all nine months of pregnancy.⁽⁴⁾

Black women are **more than three times** as likely as white women to have an abortion.⁽⁵⁾

In Philadelphia, **nearly half** of all black babies are aborted.

In one year, **10,880** black babies were born in Philadelphia while **9,259** were aborted.⁽⁶⁾
