8 FACTS ABOUT ABORTION

1. There is a Constitutional right to life in the U.S. *The Bill of Rights guarantees it.*
2. Human life and personhood begin at conception. *This is a scientific and indisputable fact.*
3. Roe v. Wade and its companion case Doe v. Bolton legalized abortion nationwide for virtually any reason throughout all nine months of pregnancy. *The Court permitted abortion in the third trimester.*
4. Abortion was legalized in 1973 by Supreme Court Justices, who by their own admission, did not know when life begins and did not consider it necessary to find out. *This was long before 4-D ultrasound.*

5. A majority of Americans, including a majority of women, oppose the permissiveness of current abortion law in the U.S. *Only 12 percent of Americans agree with current abortion policy, according to a Wirthlin poll.*
6. More than 1.3 million abortions take place each year, most of which are for convenience. *In Pennsylvania alone, the number is more than 34,000.*
7. Preborn children undergoing abortion suffer an excruciatingly painful death. *Science proves the unborn child feels pain.*
8. Abortion is traumatic to the health of the woman who aborts. *It takes a toll on the body and mind.*

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

The Constitution guarantees a right to life.

Life begins at conception.

Roe v. Wade legalized abortion throughout all nine months of pregnancy.

The U.S. Supreme Court did not know at the time of Roe when life begins.

Public opinion polls show that most people oppose abortion on demand.

More than 1.3 million abortions take place each year and most of them are not for health reasons.

Abortion is painful for both the mother and the child.
