IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER

1. Margaret Sanger opposed blacks, Jews, and Italians and believed that they should not reproduce.

2. Margaret Sanger devised a strategy of selling her eugenics plan to black pastors in order to win support in the black community.

3. Fay Wattleton, former President of Planned Parenthood, said Sanger was an “American pioneer in the truest and noblest self-sacrificing sense... Sanger’s memory is honored throughout the world by men and women who understand her monumental achievement for humanity.”
